### A different Dallas fair

Last year's inaugural **Dallas Art Fair** drew lots of press attention as well as throngs of art lovers who browsed paintings, sculpture, drawings, prints and photography from 30 or so prominent galleries from around the U.S. This year, Fort Worth's William Campbell Contemporary Art and Artspace111 will return, joining big-name galleries from Dallas, Santa Fe, New York and beyond. Campbell calls it one of the best-run art fairs he's ever attended. Catch it Feb. 5-7 at the Fashion Industry Gallery, 1807 Ross Ave., Dallas. Single-day passes are \$20, three-day passes are \$40. VIP tickets, at \$400, include admission to a gala Feb. 4 and benefit the Booker T. Washington High School for the Performing and Visual Arts.
