Les Weisbrod named president of AAJ

Dallas attorney Les Weisbrod, a partner with the firm of Miller, Curtis & Weisbrod, has been named the 2008-2009 president of the American Association for Justice (AAJ), a national trial bar that aims to give average Americans access to the civil court system. Weisbrod, who has been an AAJ member for 28 years, represents families and individuals in wrongful death and injury medical malpractice lawsuits. One of his most well-known cases involved a client who sued Baylor University Medical Center in Dallas after negligent care left the patient a quadriplegic. Weisbrod won the case for his client, and the suit was subsequently named one of the 100 most important verdicts in the United States by the *National Law Journal* in 2003.
