MALPRACTICE IS CLAIMED The wife of the former Cowboys running back Ron Springs is suing two doctors she accuses of letting him slip into a coma last October. The medical malpractice lawsuit filed Tuesday by Adriane Springs seeks unspecified damages. Ron Springs appeared to have been improving after receiving a new kidney from his former teammate Everson Walls in March. Springs had Type 2 diabetes, which led to the amputation of his right foot. But Springs, 51, has remained in a coma since an Oct. 12 operation that relatives believed was a routine procedure to remove a cyst on his left forearm.
